CONSEQUENCES OF DEFAULT

I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DEFAULT ON MY STUDENT LOAN (S), THE FOLLOWING MAY HAPPEN:

1. I will lose my right to receive additional Federal Financial Aid including student loans and Pell Grants.
2. The Department of Education will report to a credit bureau that I failed to pay my loan (s).
3. I will not be able to receive credit for buying a car or other goods for at least seven (7) years.
4. The Department of Education will purchase the loan from the lender.
5. I will owe the Department of Education all payments, interest principal, late charges, collection charges, and reasonable attorney fees. I understand these fees may be substantial.
6. I understand that the Department of Education can hire a professional collection agency to collect my loan (s) and I will have to pay these charges.
7. I understand that Department of Education may sue me to collect the loan.
8. I understand that if I am sued, I may lose part of my salary to repay the loan. I understand that if I work for the Federal Government or I am in the Military, that I may lose part of my salary to repay the loan.
9. I understand that if I default and do not have the money to pay the loan (s), the Department of Education may wait to sue me until I have the money.
10. I understand that if I default on my student loan (s), my Federal and/or State Income Tax refunds may be used to repay the loan and I will not receive the tax return.
11. I understand that the Federal Government will then collect the loan from me.

Stipend checks are distributed once a month on the 3rd Thursday of each month. Checks are distributed as follows: during the Day Session, after 12:30 p.m., the PM Session, after 5:00 p.m., and during the Night Session, after 10:00 p.m. from the Dean's Office.

Further, I understand that any problem (s) with my Financial Aid paperwork, including missing documentation, will result in a delay of receiving my stipend.

I also understand that from time to time I will be receiving letters The Department of Education. If I do not understand these letters, I will bring them to the Financial Aid Office and they will explain them to me.
